Proposed changes shown below (deletions marked by strike out, new text in red).

- 7. Biennial Annual General Meeting
- (a) An Biennial Annual General Meeting shall be held at a date and place decided by the Committee.
- (b) The business shall comprise a report, a financial statement, the election of officers, and any other matters as may properly be put before the meeting.
- (c) Notice and agenda of the meeting shall be circulated at least one month beforehand.
- (d) Nominations for office shall be accepted up to the time of and from the meeting.
- (e) The quorum for the Biennial Annual General Meeting shall be fifteen financial members.
- (f) As soon as possible following each Annual General Meeting, the Treasurer will lodge the set of annual accounts approved at the meeting on the Incorporated Societies website.
